**Minute:**

- Paul Bailey welcomed as the UCC incoming Chairman.
- **Police report:** No police report was available (meeting dates had been changed due to local events)
- **Previous Minutes** acceptance proposed by Paul Bailey, seconded by George Duncan.
- **Declaration of Interest:** No declaration of interest noted.

**New Items:**

- **Tidy Village scheme.** Explorer Scout group provided 14 volunteers to engage in a mass Litter Pick in Pitmedden on Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> August. Event went well with multiple bags full of miscellaneous litter, bottles and cans recovered. A second 'pick' has been agreed for late October / Early November, date to be agreed. Payment to be arrange on receipt of invoice from the Scout group.
- **Formartine Planning Committee.** (Bonnyton Farm development). Agreement that Garth Entwistle would attend representing Pitmedden. Committee meeting scheduled for 3<sup>rd</sup> September.
- *At this point Colin Duncan (secretary) excused himself after receipt of notification of a sudden family bereavement. Following minute taken from notes provided by chair.*
- **Meeting attendance:** Brief discussion regarding the importance of UCC member attendance. Members in attendance acknowledged the importance of regular attendance and critical requirement of a Quorate attendance.
- **Co-Opt of Heather Black.** Requirement to Co-Opt Heather Black onto the council was a result of failure to include Heather in the Election process of June 2019. Co-Opt of Heather was agreed unanimously by attending members in accordance to the Constitution. Election of 2020 must include Heather Black, making provision for change to elected member.
- **Updates on running settlement issues:**
  - Udny Green parking issues --- pending meeting with Roads Department representative.

- Defibrillators --- Hatton Crook. Still awaiting opportunity to relocate unit to permanent location.
- Traffic Speed Signs --- to be discussed at future meeting.
- **Planning applications:** Other than Bonnyton Farm development no other applications of concern.
- **Noteable Items received by email.**
  - Community Councillor Event scheduled for 28<sup>th</sup> September. Members encouraged to apply. Deadline to reserve place being 30<sup>th</sup> August 2019.
  - Planned changes to Kerbside collections posted on Udney.online website.

    - Formartine Local Development Plan 2021 Analysis presentation scheduled over 10<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup> September in the Kirk Centre Ellon. It is desirable that a member of Udney attends the presentation to observe the Pitmedden / Milldale, Udney Green and Hattoncrook discussion.
